

Presentation and Poster Guidelines

Oral Presentation Guidelines

Please read the following information if you are giving an oral presentation:

- 1. Speakers will be given 20 minutes for their presentation, including time for questions.
- 2. Please bring your presentation on a flash drive (USB) and be sure to have a backup of your presentation. Presentation format should be PowerPoint 2003 or 2007. We suggest you also bring a .pdf file of your presentation.
- 3. Please check in at the registration desk when you arrive and, if possible, at least 24 hours prior to your talk. This will enable us to load presentation on laptops.
- 4. Please check in with the session moderator before the beginning of your session.

Poster Guidelines

Please read the following information if you are presenting a poster:

- 1. Posters should be <u>in portrait format</u> and maximum size of 90cm X 120 cm (36" X 48"). We will provide poster boards and push pins for you to mount your poster.
- 2. Posters should be set up in the poster social room before Monday 13 h.
- 3. Posters will be on display for the entire symposium but authors should be present at their poster during the official poster session.
- 4. Poster should be taken down at the end of the symposium.
